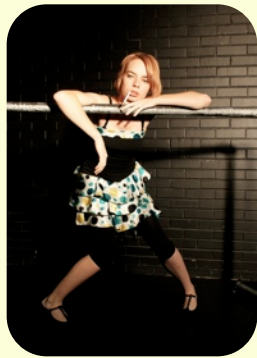

Styles of Broadway A Dedication to Miss Dot

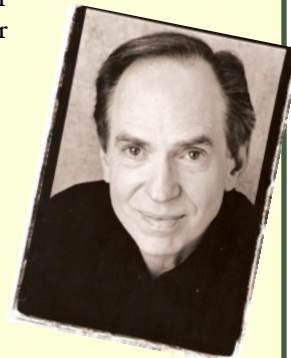
